**The Global Reference Center offers online access to databases in five different languages; content and coverage vary significantly between each resource. The (French) Encyclopaedia Universalis has 33,000 standard articles, weekly and monthly special features, graphics and animations, an atlas, a dictionary, and links to selected Web sites. The exhaustive Enciclopedia Universal en Espanol features over 47,000 articles, images, a dictionary, an atlas, and timelines. The Chinese material comes from the Britannica Pocket Encyclopaedia, with more than 14,000 articles, images, and maps in Simplified Chinese, and it has English article headings. Encyclopaedia Britannica Online Japan is the most comprehensive, with 155,000 articles, 8,500 images, illustrations and maps, and annual updates from the Britannica International Yearbook. Britannica Online Korea includes more than 110,000 articles, the Korean Britannica Book of the Year, and Yonsei University's Korean Dictionary. Each database features an intuitive interface, and experienced researchers should have no problems navigating the sites regardless of their level of language proficiency. . . .
